Duncan Millard became Chief Statistician and the Head of the IEA Energy Data Centre in March 2015. Previously he was the Chief Statistician for the UK Department of Energy and Climate Change (DECC) for ten years, where he was a co-creator of the DECC School and he and his staff received three Royal Statistical Service awards for Excellence in Official Statistics. His experience with international statistical work prior to the IEA included membership in both the IEA and Eurostat energy statistics groups as well as extensive work with the Joint Organisations Data Initiative (JODI) and its constituent organisations.

Before DECC, Mr. Millard's managerial experience included the reform and modernisation of statistics in the States of Jersey and, as Director of Energy Statistics and Energy Efficiency at the UK Department of Business Enterprise and Regulatory Reform, work on the development of the understanding of options to decarbonise heat use that ultimately led to new government policies. He also served as Head of Energy Security and Electricity Policy at the UK Department of Trade and Industry.
