



Call for Papers

The 20th Anniversary Windsor Workshop on Transportation “Towards Sustainable Transportation”

The Windsor Workshop on Transportation is celebrating its 20th anniversary in Toronto, Ontario from June 2 – 5, 2003. To mark this occasion, the event will be expanded to address a broader, more global range of transport issues than at previous Windsor Workshops. The Selection Committee is currently accepting abstracts for presentations in the following areas:

Policy issues – strategies for reducing environmental impacts such as pollutant and GHG emissions; improving energy security; and improving sustainability through fuel economy improvements; increased use of alternative fuels; mode switching and other behavioral changes; and increased technology transfer between countries.

Regulations and standards – innovative regulatory design, harmonization, emission and fuel economy test cycles and emissions modeling.

Technology -- for heavy and light duty vehicles – vehicle efficiency (light weight materials, improved aerodynamics); emissions (measurement techniques, test cycles, real world vs laboratory results); fuels (alternative, additives, advanced diesel, bio-fuels, production and renewables); engines (HD and LD, stratified charge, compound); infrastructure (on-site reforming of hydrogen, compression, and fuel delivery); and vehicles (hybrids, OBD, regeneration technologies, transitional vehicles).

Programs – Fleet trials and demonstrations (fuels, emission technologies, routing, transponders, truck and transit) and I & M programs.

Transportation Systems – intelligent highways, transit systems and land use; freight (border crossing, routing, HD telemetry), travel demand models; and inter-modal systems.

A one-page (200-300 words) detailed description of your presentation must be submitted to the Windsor Workshop Secretariat for review. All submissions must be received by October 4, 2002. Successful presenters will be notified by October 30, with final papers to be submitted by Mar 15, 2003.
