Bo Diczfalusy was appointed Director of the Directorate of Sustainable Energy Policy and Technology at the International Energy Agency (IEA) on 1 December 2009.

Prior to joining the IEA, Mr. Diczfalusy - a Swedish national - spent much of his career in the Swedish government working on energy and climate change policy issues. Mr. Diczfalusy was the Programme Director of the Energy Programme at the Federation of Swedish Industries from 1997 until 2003. Most recently, he served as Director-General for Energy and Head of the Energy Division of the Swedish Ministry of Enterprise, Energy and Communications, and was the Swedish representative to the IEA Governing Board from 2003 to 2009. In 2009, Mr. Diczfalusy played a prominent role during the Swedish Presidency of the European Union.

Mr. Diczfalusy graduated from the Stockholm School of Economics with a degree in International Economics.
