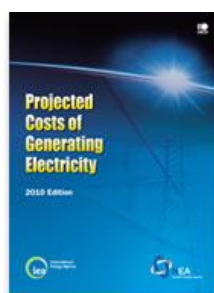

**What are the costs of generating electricity?
A long-awaited study provides the latest figures...**



The new edition of ***Projected Costs of Generating Electricity - 2010 Edition***, a joint report by the International Energy Agency (IEA) and the OECD Nuclear Energy Agency (NEA), presents the latest data available for a wide variety of fuels and technologies including coal and gas (with and without carbon capture and storage), nuclear, hydro, onshore and offshore wind, biomass, solar, wave and tidal as well as combined heat and power (CHP).

Mssrs. Tanaka and Echávarri will present the main findings of the study which includes data from almost 200 power plants in 17 OECD member countries and four non-OECD countries, supported by over 130 figures and tables; it will serve as an incomparable tool for all those working on energy policies and climate change.
