

Czech republic round table contribution

1. Legislative process of the amendment of the Energy Economy Act with respect to the implementation of the EU directive 2002/91 has been accomplished. Herewith the energy efficiency requirements for buildings of EU are fully harmonized in Czech legislation.
2. The Czech government approved the Report on the outlook of renewable energy production for the period to 2020. The level of renewable energy on the total consumption of primary energy sources has been projected at 8.6%.
3. The expert group nominated by the government that shall submit a review of the current State Energy policy made a good progress. Preliminary assessments support the idea of further development of nuclear power. This non-emitting proven technology can help in the short term to overcome a potential shortage of electricity in the country. The Parliament call on the government to submit a report in the middle of next year.
